NEGOTIATIONS COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

Tuesday, May 19, 2020

Virtual Meeting

The Negotiations Committee held a virtual meeting via Zoom on **Tuesday, May 19, 2020**. Present were Committee members Julie Bruni, Nathan Carlow, James Moses, and Arthur Payeur, Jr. Also present were Kimberly Aiken, SVISPA President; Amanda Thiele, SVISPA Vice President; Trevor Hustus, Board Chairperson; Paul Penna, Superintendent of Schools; Jennifer Barschdorf, Human Resources Manager; and Hedy Smith, Executive Secretary.

Mr. Moses called the meeting to order at **5:07** p.m.

- 1. Executive Session Pursuant to 1 MRSA § 405 (6)(d) to Review the Side Letter Regarding the Provision of a Paid Hourly Wage Option Ratified on August 19, 2019, by the MSAD 6 Board of Directors and the Saco Valley Instructional Support Personnel Association (SVISPA)**
