Wondering how to pay for college?

Representatives from the Finance Authority of Maine (FAME) will be on hand for a Financial Aid info session. The info session will begin at 6:00 p.m. and go until 7:30 p.m. A FAFSA Completion Lab will follow this info session. This lab is where you will complete and submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). ***Lab is only for students planning to attend college January 2020. Only those attending the Completion Lab will need to bring certain documents with them:***

- Last year's Federal tax return or other income documentation
- Social Security Number
- Driver's License
- Last year's W-2 forms or year-end pay stubs and other year-end records of money received
- Last year's untaxed income records (Social Security, TANF, Welfare or Veterans' benefits)
- Last year's bank statements
- Business, mortgage and investment information
- Your alien registration card if you are not a U.S. citizen

Although this workshop is FREE, you must pre-register with Bonny Eagle Adult Education. Please bring a laptop for the Completion Lab.
